

8.20 \$AAM

Description:

Read the name of the device.

Command Syntax:

\$<u>AAM</u>[<u>CS</u>](CR)	
\$	Delimiter character
<u>AA</u>	Address of the device to be configured in hexadecimal format (00 to FF)
M	Command to read the device's name
[<u>CS</u>]	Checksum
(CR)	Carriage Return

Response:

Valid Command: **!AA(Data)[CS](CR)**

Invalid Command: **?AA[CS](CR)**

!	Delimiter for a valid command
?	Delimiter for an invalid command
<u>AA</u>	Address of the responding device
(<u>Data</u>)	Name of the device
[<u>CS</u>]	Checksum
(CR)	Carriage Return

Examples:

Reads the device name. Command sent to the ED-588 and a valid response is returned with the device's name, ED-588.

Command: **\$01M(CR)**

Response: **!01ED-588(CR)**
