

## ~aa4n

Applies to: ED-560

Description:

Command to read the safe value of channel n.

Command Syntax:

<b>~aa4n[CS](CR)</b>	
~	Delimiter character
<b>aa</b>	Address of the device in hexadecimal format (00 to FF)
4	Command to read the safe value
<b>n</b>	The channel to be read (0 to F)
<b>[CS]</b>	Checksum
(CR)	Carriage Return

Response:

Valid Command: **!aa(Data)[CS](CR)**

Invalid Command: **?aa[CS](CR)**

!	Delimiter for a valid command
?	Delimiter for an invalid command
<b>aa</b>	Address of the device
<b>(Data)</b>	Safe value of channel specified
<b>[CS]</b>	Checksum
(CR)	Carriage Return

Examples:

Send command to read safe value of channel 0.

Command: ~0140(CR)

Response: !01+00.000(CR)
