The document described the instructions on how to install **VMware Workstation Trial** product on **Microsoft Windows 7 (32-bit) Operating System**. The user should also be able to follow the same steps of instructions outlined below and adapt them for other Microsoft Operating Systems such as **Windows XP** and so on.

At the time of writing this document, the current version of **VMware Workstation** is **version 9**. Please also be aware that the process and steps described below to help the user register for a free “**My VMware**” account are subject to change in the future. These steps are given only as a guide, and not to be confused as a definitive manual. For up-to-date information, it is strongly recommended that the user consults the official documents and guide provided by **VMware Inc.** by visiting: <http://www.vmware.com>

Please skip **Step 1 – 10** if you have already purchased **VMware Workstation** product and have a valid licence key.

NOTE: Please do not proceed further until you’ve completed the steps outlined below to obtain a trial copy of VMware Workstation and a valid trial licence key

1. In order to download and obtain a copy of **VMware Workstation** product, the user would have to register for a free **My VMware** account with **VMware, Inc.** website. This is required in order for the user to be given a valid licence key which the user would have to enter during the installation process.

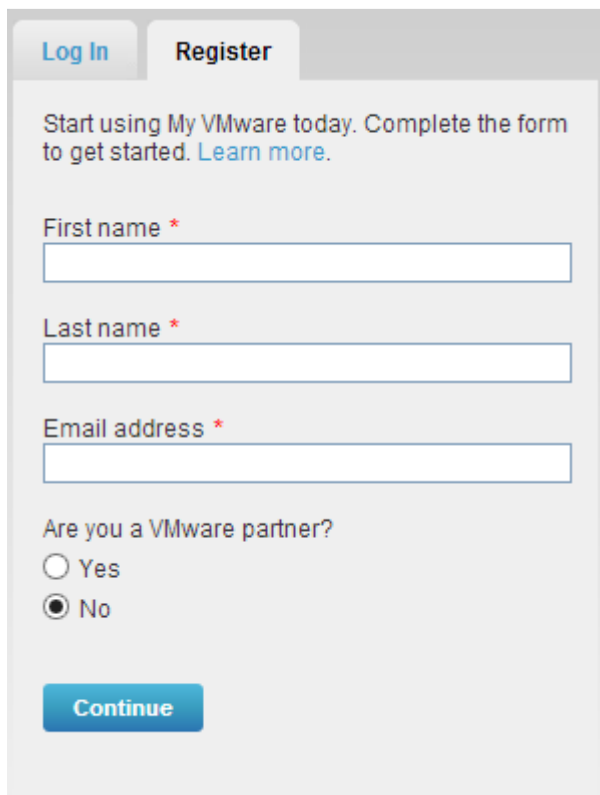

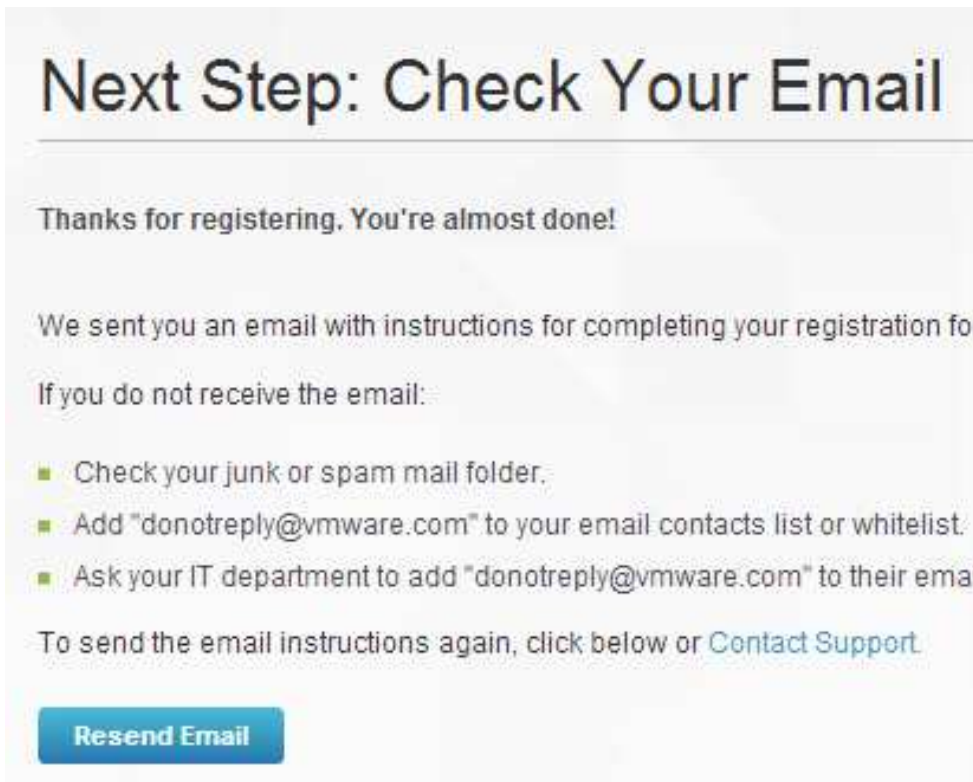

Please follow the instructions outlined as shown above in order to activate your newly registered account.

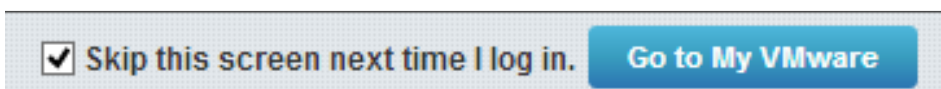
3. Log into your **My VMware** account by following this link:

Click "**Go to My VMware**".

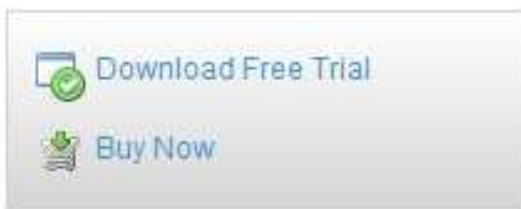

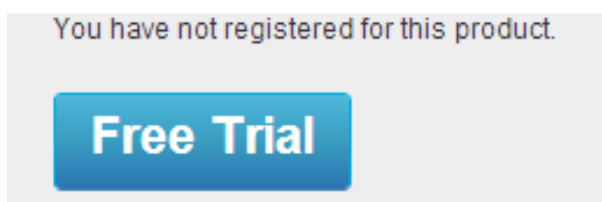
- Next, hover your mouse over to “**Products & Downloads**”, and then click on “**All Downloads**” link from the webpage as shown in the screen shot below:

- Click the link “**Free Trial**” as shown in the screen shot below:

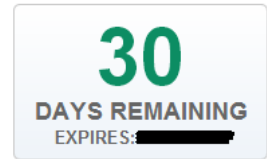


9. You will then be taken to a webpage similar to the one shown below in the screen shot:

10. For this demonstration, we will be using the Windows version of **VMware Workstation**. Therefore, click on “**Download**” as shown below in the screen shot:

Save the executable file to a location on your PC.

This could take a while depending on the speed of your Internet connection.

Once the executable file is downloaded, we could proceed to the next phase of installing the **VMware Workstation** evaluation product onto a PC.
